Postcards with each team's selection time will be mailed to the team Captains.
- **Parking:** The City has made available a dirt lot at Central park, which opens up 400 more parking spaces! Make sure to get all motor home and requests in ASAP. Space is limited. Find the form/instructions on the website.
- Youth Waivers: Turn in money and registration forms at the next Captain's meeting on May 11th and at Campsite Selection Night. All participants under age 18 MUST have a waiver signed by a parent/guardian (even if they are registered on line). Find the form/instructions on the website.
- Survivor Raffle Baskets: The survivor committee is looking for donations of raffle baskets. So far there are 250 registered survivors with many more expected. - Campsite Judging: Captains will be given a ballot in their packet. Each captain may choose 3 campsites for each category: 1) best mission delivery/fight back, 2) best day of event fundraiser, and 3) best overall campsite (appearance, mission, team working the booth and activities). Captains must turn in their ballot to the box in the Captains' site at the Info Booth by 2 pm. The Captains' Council will tally the votes, view the top 3 campsites for each category, and select the top campsites and a runner-up. Yard signs and surprise prizes will be awarded. Watch for the "prize patrol" to come to "your" campsite! The CC will also be choosing 2 "Night Owl" winners...the teams that are up and staying active in the wee hours of the morning. Winning teams can carry their yard signs in the last "team lap" to brag!
- Program Book: If you were not at the April Captains' meeting, please send your CC mentor the following info ASAP: Your team name, the Captain's and Co-Captain's full names, what activities will be at your campsite and what your Fight Back activity/message is. Also, if you would like to place an ad in the Relay Program, the deadline is Monday, May 3. For more information, see the Ad Request Form.
- Info Booth: (Formerly Registration Tent): Money can be dropped off and change requests can be turned at the INFO BOOTH during designated hours when we will have security present at the booth.
 Guest and group waivers will be available at the Info Booth.
- Important Rules to Remember: No liquor at the campsites or in
 the baskets (including wine). Food may NOT be sold at Relay, unless it
 is commercially packaged in individual packages. No home-made
 baked goods, root beer floats, iced tea (cans of soda/juice and
 prepackaged candy, cookies are okay). No dogs allowed. Check out

 right side to answer your questions about registration, donations, rules,
 vendors, campsite selection night, campsite set up, and "what"

Got your team banner? All teams should have a banner with the team name on it for the first and final "team laps" of Relay. You can make it yourself or have one professionally made. But please remember, you may not place the Relay For Life logo on your banner (or any other printed material), however, you may use the words "Relay" or "Relay For Life". Check out this link for some suggested banner companies and important rules. (If anyone knows another sign/banner company where teams can get a discount, please let us know!) We suggest you don't put the year on the banner so it can be used more than once.
