- **Food:** Our food chairs, Betsy and Mike Keesler, have been hard at work to insure that there will be a wide selection of food vendors at our event.
  - This year there will **not** be food tickets sold....food can be purchased with cash!
  - **NEW!** Each team member who raises \$100 will get a free lunch AND dinner voucher!
- **Luminaria:** Luminaria bags can be purchased for \$10. Don't forget...a bag can be purchased for a pet. All Luminaria money must be turned in BEFORE the event for it to count toward your team fundraising amount.

- **Fundraisers:** Please send information about your team fundraisers to Info@SCVRelay.org so it can be publicized on the Relay calendar. If the fundraiser needs a flyer, send her a copy for other teams to print. Check the calendar often to see what new fundraisers have been added! Let's get out there and support team fundraisers!!
- **Team Captain Fundraiser Raffle:** There are 2 ways for Team Captains to win "Relay Bucks" at each month's meeting:
  - Schedule a team fundraiser on the website, and
  - Attend another team's fundraiser. Get a flyer signed or bring a receipt and turn them into Teresa before/at the meeting. You can get up to 3 raffle tickets for team members who attended EACH fundraiser.
- **Relay Bucks:** These can be used to purchase merchandise from the Relay Store. Each \$5 in Relay Bucks must be matched with \$5 cash/check to make your purchase. Relay Store is set up at Captains' meetings and at the event. You must be present at the meeting to win any prizes – that includes Relay Bucks given to the teams who reach Fundraising Club goals.
- **TC Meeting Bonus:** Bring your loose change to the Captains' meeting and add it to the bucket. You may be the lucky team who wins the pot! This month CHEMO AMIGOS won \$65.50 to add to their fundraising total!
